Parade Line Up for Parkwood Beach: Merchants Way behind the Wareham Fire Station. Float riders must arrive no earlier than 9:00 a.m. and no later than 9:40. Our parade float steps off at 10:00 a.m.

Restroom Facilities: Merchants Way will have restrooms at the train station and a porta potty will be available.

Free Parking for Participants Only: Parking is only available for participants. This will be discussed further in detail once we have our list of participants.

Parade Route: The parade will exit at the end of Merchants Way farthest from the Fire Station and start near Besse Park - proceeding down Main Street to Centre Park where the Ceremony will take place.
